The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) Project Specific Plan (PSP) for the inactive flyash pile and soil stockpile 5 (SP5).

This PSP provides information for collecting characterization data using real-time instruments during excavation of the inactive flyash pile and SP5. The characterization data will be used to determine whether soils and soil-like materials meet the waste acceptance criteria for the on-site disposal facility.

The PSP adequately details the above characterization activities. Therefore, U.S. EPA approves the inactive flyash pile and SP5 PSP.
