The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) Area 1, Phase 1 (A1,P1) west impacted soil stockpile Waste Acceptance Criteria (WAC) attainment report.

The report summarizes data from the west impacted soil stockpile and concludes that the soil in the stockpile meets the WAC for the On-Site Disposal Facility (OSDF).

U.S. EPA concurs with the results, approves the report and recommends the material be placed in the OSDF.
