In accordance with the approved Remedial Action Work Plan (RAWP) for Operable Unit 1 (OU1) and its Amendment, this letter transmits the Remedial Design (RA) Documents Package, developed by International Technology (IT) Corporation, for review and approval. This Package contains the following four documents identified in the approved RAWP for OU1:

- Operations & Maintenance Plan for Remediation Facilities
- Operations Environmental Control Plan
- Remedial Action Health & Safety Plan
- Sampling & Analysis Plan

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In addition, this RA Package includes the following two additional documents that require review and approval by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) and Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA):

- Performance Test Criteria
- Stormwater/Wastewater Management Plan

The Performance Test Criteria contains IT's plan for the testing to be performed on the dryer stack emissions. The Stormwater/Wastewater Management Plan is a document promised to the EPAs in response to several comments made by the EPAs through their review of IT's Remedial Design Package.

A summary description of the contents of each of these elements is provided in front of the Package.

DOE request early comments, if at all possible, on the Sampling and Analysis Plan. Early receipt of comments will assist in coordination efforts with Envirocare and its agency requirements.
