**TASK ORDER NUMBER 405 IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE FOR ABOVE-GRADE
DECONTAMINATION AND DISMANTLEMENT FOR FIVE COMPONENTS OF THE
MISCELLANEOUS SMALL STRUCTURES COMPLEX**

Reference: "Miscellaneous Small Structures Implementation Plan for Above-Grade
Decontamination and Dismantlement," dated August 1998, Section 4.0.

Enclosed is the Department of Energy (DOE) implementation documentation regarding the
above-grade Decontamination and Dismantlement (D&D) of five components that are
included in the Miscellaneous Small Structures (MSS) Complex Implementation Plan (IP).

As stated in Section 1.2 in the final version of the MSS-IP, commencement of work will be
authorized through the issuance of a Task Order, which may include the D&D of more than
one component. Also, per Section 4.0, an implementation schedule will be submitted
which contains three regulatory milestones: 1) Notice to Proceed; 2) Start of Field
Activities; and 3) Completion of Field Activities.

Accordingly, you will find enclosed the implementation schedule for Task Order #405,
which includes component 8F - Plant 8 Old Drum Washer; 22A - Gas Meter Building;
39B - Waste Oil Decant Shelter; 39C - Incinerator Sprinkler Riser House; and 45B - Utility
Shed.
