### NOTIFICATION OF AN EXCEEDANCE OF 20 $\mu\text{g/L}$ MONTHLY AVERAGE URANIUM CONCENTRATION AT THE PARSHALL FLUME

Reference: Letter, J. W. Reising to J. A. Saric and T. Schneider, "Notification of an Anticipated Exceedance of 20  $\mu\text{g/L}$  Monthly Average Uranium Concentration at the Parshall Flume," dated December 30, 1998

Based on preliminary data for the month of December 1998, the Fernald Environmental Management Project (FEMP) monthly average uranium concentration in water discharged to the Great Miami River was 23.6  $\mu\text{g/L}$ . This notification is being submitted to you at this time per requirements of the approved Operations and Maintenance Master Plan for Aquifer Restoration and Wastewater Treatment Project (OMMP) (November 1997).

As indicated in the referenced letter, the Department of Energy (DOE) will discuss circumstances surrounding the stormwater bypass that caused the exceedance during the January 12, 1999, conference call.

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
