The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) Waste Acceptance Criteria (WAC) report for Area 7 (A7).

The WAC report summarizes analytical results and in-situ gamma spectroscopy results from the Operable Unit 4 soil remediation A7 to determine whether the soil meets the WAC for the On-Site Disposal Facility. U.S. EPA finds the document acceptable and work can be initiated in March 1999 as scheduled.
