The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) Area 8, Phase 2 (A8,P2) and Area 6 triangle area certification design letter, and project specific plan for certification sampling and drainage ditch investigation.

The certification letter describes the approach for documenting the A8,P2 and the A6 triangle area meet final remediation levels, and the project specific plan describes the approach for conducting real-time scanning and collecting physical samples of the same area.

The reports appear technically adequate and are consistent with other similar documents. Therefore, U.S. EPA approves the above mentioned A8,P2 and A6 triangle area reports.
