The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) Area 1, Phase II Trap Range verification of treatment sampling plan.

The plan provides a sampling and analysis strategy for confirming that the treated soil in the trap range meets or exceeds the requirements of the toxicity characteristic leaching procedure test for lead and arsenic; and passes the paint filter liquids test.

The document appears adequate and the sampling plans appears to meet its objectives. Therefore, U.S. EPA approves the trap range verification sampling plan.
