Waste pit excavation and rail shipment update

Fernald plans to transport two trains containing approximately 106 railcars of pit waste to Envirocare of Utah during the first two weeks of November. Since pit excavation began in September, Fernald has excavated over 25,000 tons of material. The material encountered during excavation has been consistent with historical information; no significant anomalies have been found. Since operations began in February, Fernald has loaded over 62,500 tons of material associated with Operable Unit 1 into railcars. Certification of soil continues

Over the life of the cleanup, samples from all of the soil at the Fernald site will be analyzed to certify that clean-up levels have been achieved. Over the next two months, Area 1, Phase III (the northern wooded lot) will undergo site preparation prior to soil sampling. Surveying and brush clearing are required to prepare an area for sampling. 
