Waste pit excavation and rail shipment update

Over 27,000 tons of waste pit material have been excavated since September. Fernald anticipates completing start-up testing of the dryers and initiating full-scale treatment operations in November. The next train (Train 13) is scheduled to leave Fernald for the 1,900 mile trip to Envirocare in mid to late November. Since April, Fernald has transported 12 trains (620 railcars) containing approximately 68,000 tons of Waste Pits Project material to Envirocare. 
