Waste pit excavation and rail shipment update

The Waste Pit Project team continues to excavate and process Pit 3 waste. To date, approximately 52,000 tons of material have been excavated from the waste pits. Fernald plans to transport Train 18 to Envirocare in late January. To date, Fernald has transported over 96,000 tons of material (893 railcars) to Envirocare by rail. NSC Energy Services of Knoxville, Tenn., the contractor selected to demolish the Plant 6 Complex, received notification to mobilize from Fluor Fernald on Jan. 10. NSC will mobilize and start bringing personnel on site for training and engineering analysis. Other activities include sealing the building and establishing laydown areas. The Decontamination and Dismantlement (D&D) work in the former Metals Fabrication Plant will begin this summer. 
