Silos project update

Silo 3 project contractor, Rocky Mountain Remediation Services (RMRS), is continuing site preparation construction activities in support of final waste recovery treatment and disposal of the Silo 3 contents. An Interim Storage Area (ISA) will be graded in preparation for the placement of the concrete pad. The ISA will be used for staging treated Silo 3 material containers while awaiting sampling results. The ISA pad will be approximately one acre in size and will be located east of the Silo 3 treatment facility. Storm sewers will be placed within the ISA to collect and control run-off.


