Demolition Projects update

Decontamination and Demolition (D&D) activities continue in Plant 6, the former Metals Fabrication Plant. MACTEC, the subcontractor performing the work, will focus on the demolition of the Old Ingot Furnace Stack, located inside Plant 6. Additional interior activities will include below grade demolition of Area 2 Rolling Mill equipment and removal of ductwork and asbestos contaminated material in Area 3, the Inspection and the Water Treatment Area.

MACTEC is also continuing with structural steel removal activities at Plant 5.

Construction activities continue on the walls of the Transfer Tank Area (TTA) Building of the Silos Accelerated Waste Retrieval Project. Site preparation for the pipe rack foundations is also in process.
