The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) five year review for the Fernald Environmental Management Project (FEMP).

The five year review is a statutory requirement for National Priority List sites conducting cleanups under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act. The document provides a five year review of the remedial actions being conducted for all five operable units at the FEMP.

The document appears technically adequate and consistent with U.S. EPA guidance, however, U.S. EPA has attached a few minor comments that need to be incorporated into the document. Therefore, U.S. EPA concurs with the five year review.


U.S. DOE must submit a revised five year review document incorporating the changes within thirty (30) days receipt of this letter.
