The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) revised management plan for the On-Site Disposal Facility (OSDF) material transfer area.


The document describes the construction of Bulk Debris Transfer Areas (BDTA), Container Transfer Areas (CTA), management controls used during bulk debris transfer, bulk debris placement, inspections and decommissioning of the BDTA, and a plan for establishing future BDTAs and CTAs.

U.S. DOE has adequately incorporated U.S. EPA's previous comments into the document. This latest revision details the plans for future bulk BDTAs and CTAs. U.S. EPA approves the development of all the areas proposed in this document.

Therefore U.S. EPA approves the latest revision to the OSDF material transfer area. If necessary, U.S. EPA is willing to consider U.S. DOE's request to expand the material transfer area in the future.
