The U. S. Department of Energy (DOE) announces the *Operable Unit 4 Draft Remedial Design Work Plan (RDWP)* at the Fernald Environmental Management Project, is now available in the Administrative Record File for public inspection. The Operable Unit 4 Draft RDWP identifies and defines activities required to develop final construction plans, specifications and bid documents for the implementation of the selected remedy described in the Record of Decision for Remedial Actions (RA) at Operable Unit 4. This work plan is a draft of the primary document to be used in the implementation of the Operable Unit 4 RD activities and has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA), as amended, the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), the Amended Consent Agreement, and the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). The Operable Unit 4 remedial design and subsequent remedial actions are being implemented by the DOE, as the lead agency responsible for CERCLA activities at the Fernald Environmental Management Project (FEMP). Since this is the initial submittal of the Operable Unit 4 Draft RDWP to the U.S. EPA, it may be subject to change based on U.S. EPA comments.
