Ohio EPA has reviewed DOE's "Use of Barium and Lead in the Surrogate Feed for Vitrification during Operable Unit 4 Pilot Plant Phase I Treatability Study" submitted to Ohio EPA on May 31, 1995. Ohio EPA approves the proposed approach for the surrogate feed with the understanding that DOE will complete this activity in compliance with all applicable RCRA requirements. In addition, Ohio EPA is interested in mass balance results for the lead and barium masses added.
