The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) Project Specific Plan (PSP) for the installation of monitoring wells in the Pilot Plant drainage ditch plume.

This PSP provides a plan for installing nine monitoring wells, including four Continuous Multilevel Tubing wells, in the Pilot Plant drainage ditch plume to monitor cleanup progress in the vicinity of the newly installed extraction wells.
