The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) Area 1, Phase 2 (A1,P2) certified for reuse areas, trap range, Sector 2C, and Sector 3 Certification Design Letter (CDL).


This document provides an approach for certifying that the equipment wash facility and its drainage line in A1,P2 have met final remediation levels.

The overall approach presented in the CDL appears adequate, however the schedule in the addendum indicates that the certification sampling occurred before the addendum was submitted to U.S. EPA for review. According to the Sitewide Excavation Plan, a CDL should be reviewed and approved by the regulatory agencies before the associated sampling begins. Future CDLs and addenda should be submitted in a timely manner and follow the procedures documented in the Sitewide Excavation Plan.

Therefore, U.S. EPA approves the A1,P2 CDL for the equipment wash facility and its drainage line.
