Decontamination and Demolition Project update

Decontamination and Demolition (D&D) activities continue in the Plant 2, 3 and 8 complexes and the General Sump. Work activities include establishing building enclosures, size reducing debris, removal of equipment, piping and interior transite and siding.

Work crews will be removing debris following demolition of Building 53A (Safety & Health Building) and Building 65 (Old Plant 5 Warehouse) in early June. Building foundations will be cleared by early July.

Silos update

Silos 1 and 2 – In June, project staff members will complete the preliminary design of the waste treatment facility and issue the Silos Warehouse and Silos 1 and 2 Mat Foundation packages for bids. They will also select a vendor for the clarifier system. The clarifier system will minimize waste volume by stabilizing water content in the Silos 1 and 2 waste stream.

Silo 3 – Work continues on civil and concrete design packages and early construction field activity.
