The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) miscellaneous small structures-Phase II project amendment #2 for above-grade Decontamination and Dismantlement (D&D) of component 35A (Silo 4).

The document details the D&D activities to take place at Silo 4. The document appears technically adequate and is consistent with other similar D&D reports.

U.S. EPA does have one minor comment. In Table 2-3 the total project material weight is estimated at 0.0 tons. This should be revised to indicate the total project material weight estimate is 896.6 tons.

Therefore, U.S. EPA approves the miscellaneous small structures-Phase II document. U.S. DOE must submit a change page for Table 2-3 within thirty (30) days receipt of this letter.
