Dear Mr. Reising:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) March 19, 2004, letter regarding placement of Asbestos Contaminated Materials (ACM) and the revised addendum 2 of the On-Site Disposal Facility (OSDF) Impacted Materials Placement Plan (IMPP).

Representatives of the U.S. EPA, U.S. DOE and Ohio Environmental Protection Agency have conducted several conference calls and met on March 18, 2004, regarding the placement of ACM in Sealand containers into the OSDF. The March 19, 2004, letter clearly defines the parameters from which U.S. DOE may handle the ACM materials in Sealand containers for placement in the OSDF. Also, the revised addendum appears technically adequate.

Therefore, U.S. EPA concurs with the ACM placement per the March 19, 2004, letter and approves the revised addendum 2 of the OSDF IMPP.
