Enclosed for your review is the Draft Comprehensive Legacy Management and Institutional Control Plan (LM&ICP). The LM&ICP has been revised based on ongoing input from the DOE Office of Legacy Management and the responses to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) Technical Review Comments submitted in March 2004.

The LM&ICP has been prepared as two distinct volumes. Volume I is the LM Plan and provides information related to Legacy Management that is more policy in nature. Volume II is the IC Plan and provides the specific requirements related to surveillance and maintenance of the Fernald Closure Project (FCP) post-closure. Volume II is being submitted as an enforceable document with USEPA, while Volume I is not. It is expected that at least one additional revision of the LM&ICP will be required prior to closure of the FCP.

The LM&ICP does contain updates to the Post Closure Care and Inspection Plan (PCCIP), the Operations and Maintenance Master Plan (OMMP) and the Groundwater/Leak Detection and Leachate Monitoring Plan (G/LD&LMP), which function as support plans. In some cases the enclosed support plans cannot be fully updated until more information is obtained closer to the closure date. The LM&ICP will be finalized prior to closure of the FCP and will have final versions of all support plans at that time.
