The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the Change to the Operable Unit (OU) 3 Building 4A Implementation Plan for Above-Grade Decontamination and Dismantlement (D and D). The existing monitoring program includes the current site-wide monitoring program and a supplemental radiological air monitoring program specifically designed for the D and D of building 4A.

The proposed change includes installing seven continuous air monitoring stations rather than eight. This change will not impact the ability of the monitoring program to meet its objectives.
