Ohio EPA has reviewed DOE's August 18, 1995 letter, "Contents of Post Record of Decision Administrative Record." Ohio EPA agrees with DOE's proposal to change procedures for document retention. Ohio EPA has the following two suggestions for improvements to the proposal. In order to avoid confusion over the scope of the records retained and where one Administrative Record ends and the other begins, Ohio EPA recommends a change of the name "Administrative Record" to "Public Record" or something similar for the post-ROD record. Secondly, the proposal should clarify the fact that DOE does not intend to maintain such a record at USEPA in the future. Elimination of this second record location seems prudent considering its' limited usage in the past.
