Enclosed for your approval is the Project Specific Plan (PSP) for the Predesign of Area 2, Phase II – Subarea 3, Revision 1. In addition to incorporating actions outlined in the responses to Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) comments (as noted in Reference 1), Revision 1 also was amended in the following manner:

- The South Field Extraction System (SFES) Valve House Area (approximately 1.25 acres) was added to the PSP.
- The Physical Sample Analytical Requirements Table (Table 2-1) was amended and corrected.
- Figure 2-3 was amended to include the SFES Valve House Area on the map.

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- Appendix B was changed to reflect needed corrections to sampling IDs, boring IDs and required analytes. It also incorporated the additional samples mandated by actions outlined in the Responses to the OEPA.

Reference 2 asked for further clarification on the OEPA Original Comment #7 as to the timing of the trailer removal in the Subcontractor and the Trailer Complex Areas. It is estimated that the trailers and any adjacent materials will be removed from the areas in question no later than October of 2004. This revision includes additional sampling and relocation of some sample points designated in this area to detect any potential impacts. Specifically, two samples were added in the Subcontractor Area adjacent to trailers and transformers. In the Trailer Complex Area, three sample points were moved and one was added. Although it was not mentioned in the OEPA comments directly, two additional samples were added to the Aquifer Project Laydown Area due to its proximity to the former Active Flyash Pile.
