The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) miscellaneous small structures phase 2 project amendment 1 for above grade Decontamination and Dismantlement (D&D) of additional components. This document summarizes the D&D activities for 19 miscellaneous small structures that were added to this project.

The implementation plan appears technically adequate and is consistent with other similar documents. However, U.S. EPA has enclosed a few minor comments.
