

REQUEST – COMPREHENSIVE LEGACY MANAGEMENT & INSTITUTIONAL CONTROLS PLAN

Reference: Letter, J. Saric to J. Reising, "Technical Review Comments on the Comprehensive Legacy Management and Institutional Controls Plan," dated September 28, 2004.

The Department of Energy (DOE) is requesting an extension for submittal of the Response to Comments (RTCs) on the Comprehensive Legacy Management and Institutional Controls Plan (LMICP) until November 24, 2004. As referenced above, U.S. EPA comments were received on September 28, 2004. The extension is needed to complete the Agency coordination required to develop RTCs for the support plans and to coordinate the review of the RTCs with the Office of Legacy Management (OLM).

DOE is further requesting an extension on submittal of the Revised LMICP until February 28, 2005. Due to the size and complexity of the LMICP and the need for ongoing coordination with OLM, revision of the document and support plans will require several months. Interim submittals of the Operations and Maintenance Master Plan for Aquifer Restoration and Wastewater Treatment (OMMP) and the Groundwater/Leak Detection and Leachate Management Plan (GWLMP) will be required to accommodate evolving operational strategies


