The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) October 19, 2004, letter requesting to send impacted concrete from Building 79, KC-2 Warehouse, and the Quonset Hut slabs to the On-Site Disposal Facility (OSDF).

The rationale presented in this letter appears technically adequate. Therefore, U.S. EPA approves the placement of the above-mentioned materials into the OSDF. However, due to the fact that most of these materials were associated with Resource Conservation and Recovery Act activities, U.S. DOE must obtain approval from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency before disposal in the OSDF.
