The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) draft certification report for the former Solid Waste Landfill (SWL), Soil Pile 7 (SP7) footprint, Stormwater Management Pond (SMP), and railyard drainage basin area, Revision A. The document provides certification information and data to demonstrate the soil in this area meets the final remediation levels.

Although this document is consistent with other certification reports, there are discrepancies within the report that must be addressed. Therefore, U.S. EPA disapproves the certification report for the SWL, SP7 footprint, SMP, and railyard drainage basin area, Revision A. U.S. DOE must submit responses to comments and a revised document within thirty (30) days receipt of this letter.
