All -

I'll be sending the draft 2010 LMICP to you on September 28th. The proposed changes to LMIC will be presented at the community meeting on October 7.

The one major proposed change is ceasing the boundary air monitoring based on an agreement reached between DOE and USEPA Office of Air and Radiation. USEPA Office of Air and Radiation determined that 3 years of air monitoring after closure was appropriate and therefore approved our position that air monitoring would cease at the end of 2009.

An additional change is the location for sediment monitoring. The previous location is now unsafe. The current new location is across the river and nearer the outfall. The change is reflected on the map in Attachment D.

Additionally, let's consider changing the LMICP revision schedule from annual to every two years. I would continue to perform annual reviews and provide change pages (if necessary) for the years that a revision is not scheduled. I am suggesting this change because operations and monitoring activities have essentially reached steady state and therefore I do not anticipate significant changes in the near term.
