

This burn will be conducted according to a prescribe burn plan that addresses Landowner information, Location Description and Map, Burn Window or Timeframe, Purpose and Objective(s) of Burn, Description of Site, Description of Fuels, Topographic Information, Preburn Preparation, personnel and Equipment Needs, Smoke Management Plan and Screening Map, Weather Factors including Windspeed and Direction, Mixing Heights, Relative Humidity (Min and Max), Temperature (Min and Max), Pre-burn and Post-burn contact list, Firing Techniques, Patrol, Mop-up, and contingency plans, Safety Considerations / site Hazards, Communications and Post Burn Evaluation.

The local fire department with jurisdiction will be notified the day of the burn. Applicant will need to request appropriate permits from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency as well.
