FCAB STRUCTURE FOR THE COMING YEAR

The FCAB decided that there will be monthly FCAB full board meetings on Saturday mornings following the Tuesday night DOE Monthly Public Briefings. There will be no meetings in December or August. Over the past few months, the Fernald Citizens Advisory Board has discussed the proposed end of the work of the Fernald Health Effects Subcommittee. The FCAB has long relied on the Fernald Health Effects Subcommittee to provide important stakeholder involvement regarding the health issues resulting from worker and community exposure to potential hazards at the Fernald site. This work is critical, but is generally outside the scope of the FCAB.

Without the Fernald Health Effects Subcommittee, the Fernald community will be extremely limited in its abilities to understand and have input to the most important aspect of the Fernald site: impacts to human health. Though past exposures have been explored, it is the potential for future exposure that is the major stakeholder concern. As we prepare to breach silos 1 and 2, excavate the worst of the waste pits, and continue placing material in the on site disposal facility, it is essential that the Fernald community understand the potential for human exposure and harm and the actions that are necessary to control these threats. The Fernald Citizens Advisory Board believes that the Fernald Health Effects Subcommittee remains the right organization for this essential work.
