In the October 22, 1990, Federal Register, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) announced it would prepare a programmatic environmental impact statement (PEIS) on its program for management of waste at currently operating facilities and cleanup of waste at inactive facilities and sites. This is a nationwide environmental restoration and waste management (EM) program under the overall direction of DOE Headquarters in Washington, D.C.

The October 22, 1990, Federal Register also identified, on page 42638, selected documents related to the PEIS that would be available in DOE Freedom of Information Reading Rooms.
