

SUBJECT: USE OF ARTIFICIAL OWLS AS BIRD DETERRENT - MBM - 089 - 95


To confirm our telephone conversation of this date, it will not violate wildlife laws or regulations to install artificial owls around the Building 371 dock areas as a bird deterrent. The Colorado Division of Wildlife often recommends this as a "scare-crow" method. Success is not assured, but moving the "owls" frequently, to emulate normal movement of the predator, is recommended.

We commend your efforts to deal with your migratory bird problems in such a proactive manner. If we can be of further assistance, please do not hesitate to call me at extension 3560 .
