Provided for your review and approval is subject report for Building 707. This Report has been revised to incorporate comments received from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) dated July 25, 2000. This report characterizes the physical, chemical and radiological hazards associated with the Trailer, summarizes the characterization activities, defines the Data Quality Objectives developed for this characterization, and presents the data quality assessment, verification and validation of results. Based upon our results, Building 707 is considered a Type 3 Facility, Buildings 778, 708, 731, 732, 718 and Cluster tanks are considered Type 2 Facilities and the remaining Facilities, i.e., Buildings 707S, and B711A are considered Type 1 Facilities.
