Subject Work Sets 34 & 40

Chris,

Per our discussion on 10-27-98 and the meeting John Rampe had in your office on 10-29-98, I am sending this e-mail to get permission to proceed with decommissioning work sets 34 & 40. The Department of Energy (DOE) considers that these two decommissioning work sets in Building 771 do not require decision documents. In accordance with the Decommissioning Program Plan, dated October 8, 1998, Figure 1 1-1, a Record of Agreement between DOE Rocky Flats Field Office (RFFO) and the Colorado Department of Health and Environment (CDPHE) is sufficient to authorize performance of this work. The work is described below.

- Set 34, Room 148 – Remove 8 unused annular tanks. The tanks were never used and are not attached to any systems, they are bolted to the floor on raised stanchions. There is contamination beneath the stainless steel floor covering in Room 148. There is no intent to work below the covering.
- Set 40, Rooms 183, 184 and 185 – Complete room stripout. These rooms consist of a drum storage area, a deactivated SNM storage vault and a small office area. These rooms are essentially uncontaminated. Stripout work would be to remove storage bins/racks, mezzanine grating and supports, and excess furniture.

All of this work is considered low risk – mechanical disassembly and minimal use of cutting tools. Although the majority of the equipment is considered to be uncontaminated, it is all located inside the building's contamination area and areas of low-level contamination are expected. Work packages and radiation surveys for these tasks will be available for oversight review at any time during development and performance. Workers are preparing work packages now and will be ready to start the work in early November. It is critical that these very low risk work sets proceed to prevent closure schedule slips. Please let me know if CDPHE approves with B771 proceeding with this work.
