**RE. Closure Description Document Approval for System #19 and #20 in Building 771**

Dear Mr Legare and Ms North

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (the Division), has reviewed the Closure Description Document (CDD) for RCRA Closure of Tanks and Ancillary Equipment in System #19 and #20 located in Building 771 at the Rocky Flats Environmental Technology Site (the Site) The CDD for System #19 and #20 was received on February 17, 1999 System #19 and #20 will be closed by the method described as "Unit Removal" in the Site's Interim Status Closure Plan, Section E As stated in this CDD, ancillary equipment will be removed during phase I of this project. The tanks associated with System #19 and #20 will remain until phase II is complete which is currently scheduled for 2006

The Division hereby approves the Closure Description Document for Closure of Tanks and Ancillary Equipment in System #19 and #20 in Building 771 with one modification The CDD states that, "For both systems, there is a length of pipe in Corridor D that is inaccessible and will not be removed at this time " The phase I summary report for these two systems, which is to be submitted to the Division within 30 days of completion, must include a revised drawing for each system which clearly identifies the remaining piping and the anticipated schedule for removal of the remaining piping In addition, the summary report should describe how the remaining piping will be dispositioned (e g , will the piping be removed as part of another tank system removal or will it be covered under a D&D workset)
