REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF "RCRA STABLE" STATUS FOR TANKS D-764 and D-765 IN SYSTEM #12 IN BUILDING 771 - KN-0XX-99

Dear Mr Tarlton

As stated in the *Phase I Summary Report of RCRA Closure Activities for Tank and Ancillary Equipment System #12 in Building 771 (RF/RMRS-99-464 UN)*, tanks D-764 and D-765 now meet the requirements for the "RCRA Stable" condition as a result of Phase I closure activities for Tank and Ancillary Equipment System #12 in Building 771 Kaiser-Hill Company, L L C requests that these tanks be approved as "RCRA Stable" with the attendant provisions

Because the tanks are now isolated from all remaining process piping, and the termination points have been sealed, no additional liquids can be introduced into the tanks In addition, the tanks are empty of liquids in that no additional liquids could be removed from the tap on the drain line at the bottom of each tank Therefore, we propose that these tanks be inspected quarterly until their removal from Building 771

Upon approval of the "RCRA Stable" status by CDPHE, the tanks will be labeled with their regulatory status and approved inspection frequency
