Dear Mr. Legare:

The Air Pollution Control Division ("Division") has received your letter dated August 28, 2001 in which you notify both the Division and the US EPA of your intention of terminating effluent monitoring in the Building 771-MAI exhaust stack by December 1, 2001. This monitoring has been used for determining compliance with 40 CFR, Part 61, Part A, Subpart H, National Emission Standards for Emissions of Radionuclides Other Than Radon From Department of Energy Facilities. Since an alternative method of demonstrating compliance with Subpart H has been approved by EPA and the Division, it is permissible for you to terminate the effluent monitoring for the decommissioning and demolition activities to be performed on Building 771.
