## REQUEST FOR MINOR MODIFICATION OF THE DECOMMISSIONING OPERATIONS PLAN (DOP) FOR THE 779 CLUSTER INTERIM MEASURE/INTERIM REMEDIAL ACTION - MEH-023-98

The purpose of this memorandum is to request notification to CDPHE of a minor modification to the 779 DOP. The intent of this minor is to clarify the quantity of gloveboxes and hoods in RCRA Unit 90.39 that will be closed during decommissioning of the 779 Cluster and to correctly identify Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) hazardous waste numbers associated with RCRA Unit 90.43.

The proposed minor modification will addend Section 9.0, Regulatory and Environmental Considerations, Table 9-1: Decommissioning the 779 Cluster, of the 779 DOP. This modification results in the correct description of all elements of RCRA Unit 90.39 and the EPA hazardous waste numbers associated with RCRA Unit 90.43.

Three gloveboxes, two hoods and Unit NC-7 were omitted from the unit description for Unit 90.39. These storage units were originally included in the June 1992 Mixed Residue Part B Permit Modification. There were also identified in the May 16, 1996 Rocky Flats RCRA Part B Permit for closure at the same time as Unit 90.39 but were not identified in the RFETS RCRA Permit dated June 30, 1997; therefore, these elements were inadvertently omitted from the Closure Description Document.

RCRA Unit 90.43 was permitted for "F" listed waste; these "F" listed wastes were not identified in Table 9-1 due to a typographical error.

All closure work for these storage units will be performed in accordance with Section 9.1.2, RCRA Closure Description Document, of the 779 DOP. Attached is a copy of the proposed minor modification notification letter to CDPHE.

SUBJECT: NOTIFICATION OF MINOR MODIFICATION OF DECOMMISSIONING OPERATIONS PLAN FOR THE 779 CLUSTER INTERIM MEASURE/INTERIM REMEDIAL ACTION (IM/IRA) EFFECTIVE DATE: FEBRUARY 6, 1998.

In accordance with the Rocky Flats Cleanup Agreement, Part 10, Changes to Work, Paragraph 127, DOE is providing written notice to CDPHE of its intent to make minor modification to work conducted pursuant to the decommissioning Operations Plan for the 779 Cluster Interim Measure/Interim Remedial Action, here after referred to as the 779 DOP. These modifications are made to:

1. Clarify our proposed work process; and
2. Correct errors and omissions.

The changes as identified in this letter are minor in nature and do not represent a major modification to the 779 DOP. The proposed minor modifications, as detailed in the following attachment, modify Section 9.0, Regulatory and Environmental Considerations, Table 9-1: Decommissioning the 779 Cluster. These modifications have been made to correctly describe all elements of Unit 90.39 and 90.43. Three gloveboxes, two hoods and Unit NC-7 were omitted from the original listing of elements describing RCRA Unit 90.39. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) hazardous waste numbers were insufficiently identified in RCRA Unit 90.43. All closure work for these units will be performed in accordance with section 9.1.2, RCRA Closure Description Document, of the 779 DOP.

RFCA does not provide a formal requirement that the Lead Regulatory Agency (CDPHE) approve minor modification to an IM/IMRA. However, Part 10 of RFCA states, "the Lead Regulatory Agency (LRA) may issue a Stop Work Order within seven days of receipt of the notification of any such modification. To avoid issuance of a Stop Work Order, it is imperative that the lines of communication between DOE and CDPHE be clearly delineated.
