ROCKY FLATS CLEANUP AGREEMENT (RFCA) STANDARD OPERATING PROTOCOL (RSOP) FOR FACILITY DISPOSITION - NOTIFICATION LETTER FOR BUILDING 866 FEG-033-03

The Facility Disposition RSOP requires that DOE notify the Lead Regulatory Agency (LRA) prior to implementing work activities pursuant to this document. The Rocky Flats Environmental Technology Site (RFETS) received concurrence from the Colorado Department of Health and Environment (CDPHE) that Building 866 was a Type 2 facility (October 17, 2001)

The purpose of this Notification is to invoke this RSOP for demolition of the facility, based on the facility meeting the free-release criteria except as noted and agreed to by CDPHE in consultative meetings (Contact Record dated September 22, 2003). Documentation of the facility meeting free-release criteria is based on the anticipated approval of the Pre-Demolition Survey Report (PDSR) submitted on September 24, 2003

As stated in the Reconnaissance Level Characterization Report (RLCR), dated September 17, 2001, and approved by CDPHE on October 17, 2001, Building 866 was characterized as a Type 2 facility. The Pre-Demolition Survey Report (PDSR) dated September 24, 2003 demonstrates Building 866 meets the free release criteria except as noted and agreed to by CDPHE in consultative meetings (Contact Record ML-018, M Lesinski, K-H and D Kruchek, CDPHE, dated September 22, 2003)
