Dear Mr. Gunderson:

Please find enclosed a completed Rocky Flats Cleanup Agreement Standard Operating Protocol (RSOP) for Component Removal, Size Reduction, and Decontamination Activities notification for Building 883 Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) units 40.27 and 40.28 closure work.

In accordance with the Component Removal RSOP, this letter notifies the Colorado Department of Public Health and the Environment (CDPHE) that the Rocky Flats Environmental Technology Site (Site) invokes the RSOP and of its intent to close interim RCRA units 40.27 and 40.28 in Building 883. Activities will be designed to achieve the closure performance standard, protect human health and the environment, and minimize waste. Specific work instructions with engineering, health and safety, and waste management information will be developed prior to start of closure activities. The instructions will be developed in accordance with applicable Site policy and procedures.

The subcontractor will conduct work in accordance with his work control documentation. The exact methods and process selection will be communicated with CDPHE through an active consultation process including monthly RISS Production Meetings and weekly project meetings. The building shell, including the floor, will not be breached during component removal activities. Questions can be directed to Steve Tower at (303) 966-2133.
