The Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (the Division) of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment has received the Rocky Flats Cleanup Agreement Standard Operating Protocol (RSOP) for Facility Disposition notification form for Building 886 explosive demolition.

The Division would like to acknowledge receipt of the RSOP notification and would like to take this opportunity to reiterate an addition agreed to in a meeting with Steve Tower (DOE), J.R. Marshall (KH), Bob Magee (CDI), and David Kruchek (CDPHE) in a meeting that took place on April 3, 2002. It was agreed that geotextile fabric will also be draped over the roof of Building 886 before the detonation to bring down the roof.
