

SUBJECT: THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIE, MIGRATORY BIRD, AND WETLAND SURVEYS AT A-3 TO A-4 PIPELINE SITE - MBM - 010 - 96

At your request Ecology personnel inspected the work area for the A-3 to A-4 Pipeline January 18, 1996. No threatened and endangered species and migratory bird concerns were identified within the planned work area. Since all work will be in upland areas, wetlands will not be impacted. As discussed, any soil disturbance, including areas where pipe-stabilization soil piles will be placed, will require revegetation once the project has been completed. Ecology is available to help plan revegetation once the final project plan has been developed. Should the current project be greatly revised, new or additional surveys will be required.
