

The purpose of this letter is to transmit the Department of Energy's (DOE) modification to the Proposed Action Memorandum (PAM): Seep Collection and Treatment for Operable Unit (OU) 7, The Present Landfill. This transmittal fulfills the IAG Milestone "Submit Revised PAM" due June 15, 1995.

The DOE would also like to request verbal confirmation from the agencies that it is not necessary to resubmit the document for a 30-day public comment period. This request is consistent with your previous verbal guidance. Although, as a courtesy to the stakeholders, the DOE would like to mention the revision to the PAM at the next quarterly public meeting.

DOE would appreciate written approval regarding this document as soon as possible. The current schedule calls for seep collection and treatment system to begin on August 16, 1995.
