

Re: OU2 IM/IRA Modification

Attached are two copies of the proposed OU2 IM/IRA Modification for your review and comment. The objective of this modification is to make the OU2 IM/IRA consistent with RFCA and the Integrated Monitoring Plan (IMP), and fully integrate the proposed Mound Site Plume Decision Document (MSPDD) for reactive metal groundwater treatment. This will be accomplished as a major modification pursuant to RFCA ¶127.

This modification includes two attachments which are described below:

Attachment 1 - Draft Mound Site Plume Decision Document

This is a stand-alone, discrete document that will govern, on an indefinite basis, the implementation, operation and monitoring of the reactive metal treatment system for the Mound Site Plume. The Mound Site Plume includes seep SW059. In the long term, Attachment 1 will be the only part of OU2 imposing continuing obligations.

Attachment 2 - Administrative Transfers

This attachment has two purposes. The first purpose is to ensure that the water sources originally addressed in the OU2 IM/IRA continue, without a lapse in coverage, to be addressed in a manner that is consistent with RFCA. The second purpose is to sever any remaining relationship between OU2 and the Consolidated Water Treatment Facility (CWTF) located in Building 891. This will be accomplished by transferring all CWTF authority to the OU1 IM/IRA Modification.
