Dear Mr. Rehder, Mr. Schieffelin, Ms. Chaki:

The implementation of Decontamination and Decommissioning (D&D) activities at Building 889 are scheduled to begin in Spring, 1996. The scope of this project includes the removal of all above ground structures and will not address the building floor, foundation, and other below grade equipment.

Although this building exists on and near portions of Operable Unit 9 (Original Process Waste Line, Individual Hazardous Substance Site (IHSS) 121) and Operable Unit 14 (IHSS 164.3), it is not expected that any disturbances will occur. If a disturbance does occur, appropriate measures will be conducted by utilizing the requirements outlined in the Environmental Approval Process for Construction/Excavation Activities, procedure number 1-F20-ER-EM-001. Process knowledge and sampling results from initial remedial investigation activities will be used to properly characterize the soils or other materials disturbed.
