Purpose of Contact: Request status of CDPHE regulatory interpretation of status of Clarifier. Can RFETS manage the Clarifier as RCRA scrap metal and send it to GTS Duratek for metal melt?

Discussion

In a phone conversation with James Hindman, CDPHE, at approximately 10:30 a.m. (May 25, 1999), I was informed that CDPHE had determined that the Clarifier had been cleaned sufficiently to be protective of human health and the environment. No further Closure operations (e.g. cleaning/sampling) are required provided the Clarifier (metal) is managed as RCRA scrap metal and sent to GTS Duratek for metal melt.

James Hindman is preparing a letter detailing the State's position on the Clarifier.
