Dear Mr. Legare:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (the Division) has reviewed the RLCR for Trailer 112B, dated May 08, 2000, received on May 11, 2000. The Division hereby concurs with the RLCR for Trailer 112B.

During the review of the information provided, the Division had some concerns with the initial Americium detection and the surveys and sampling that was conducted. Consultation with Site personnel (Tom Scott & Dave Burns) indicated that any Americium contamination that may have been associated with T112B appears to have been removed from the roof of the Trailer during sample collection and all subsequent high survey detections are the result of naturally occurring Polonium. As such, and having received and reviewed the supplemental information not originally included in the RLCR, T112B appears to be properly identified as a Type 1 Facility.
